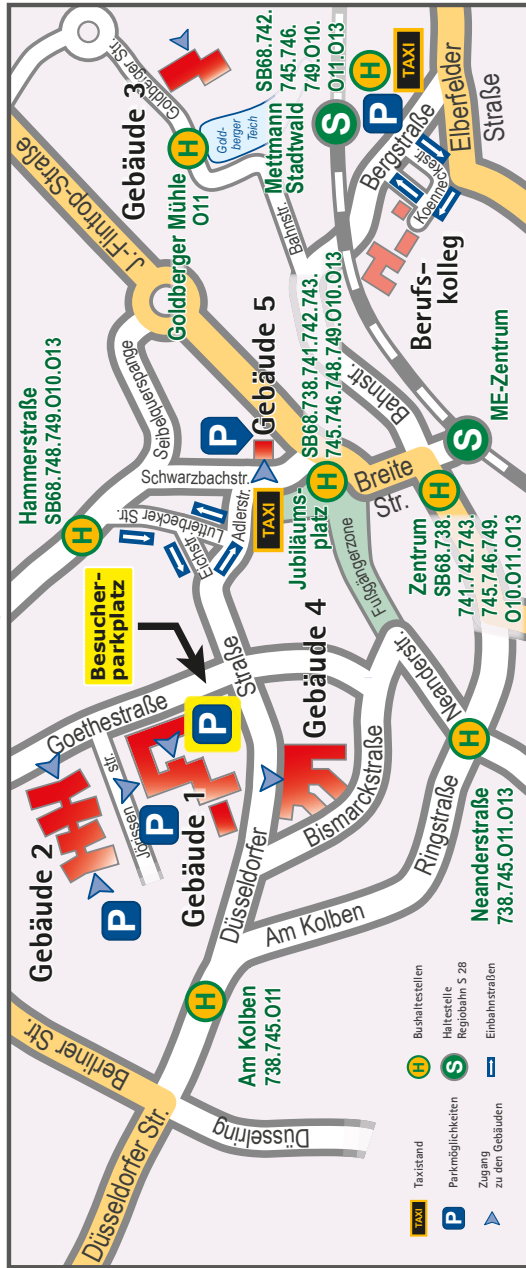

School advice for recently immigrated families

School advice for recently immigrated families

Dear parents, dear guardians,

You and your family have recently moved to the Mettmann district.

Welcome!

In Germany, all children between 6 and 18 years old must attend school. We are happy to help you in finding the right school for your child.



Is your child between 6 and 10 years old?

Then your child will attend primary school [Grundschule]. Please register your child at the primary school that is located closest to your home. A list of the schools including their addresses can be found in your city's School Administration Office [Schulverwaltungsamt], or on the following website:

Is your child between 11 and 18 years old?
Then your child will go to a secondary school.



Please call the Mettmann District Integration Centre [Kreisintegrationszentrum Mettmann]. You will be given an appointment for a consultation session on the appropriate type of secondary school and school places available to your child.

Please bring the following to your appointment:

- Your child
- Your child's passport
- Your child's registration certificate [Meldebescheinigung]
- Certificates from your country of origin
- An interpreter or German speaker. If necessary, we can arrange an interpreter.

Topics discussed in the consultation session will include:

- Previous schooling
- Possible foreign language skills
- Possible German language skills
- Knowledge of the Latin alphabet



The District Integration Centre will get in touch with a suitable school, and then give you the details about the admission appointment at the school, either by mail or in a phone call.



You register your child yourself at the arranged appointment at the school. If necessary, an interpreter can be arranged.



You will receive mail from the Health Department with an appointment for an examination with the school doctor for your child. Please be sure to attend this appointment.
